Terms and Conditions for Joining IBA DRF as a Mediator

1. Fees and payment terms

Membership to join the IBA-DRF Panel of Mediators as a Mediator is free, however, every mediator must undertake at least one professional development course in a calendar year with IBA. Each professional development course determines its own fees which may be found on its respective webpage or a mediator may email at (insert email here) for more information.

2. Copyright

The copyright and all other intellectual property rights remain the sole and exclusive property of IBA-DRF. In joining the panel, you undertake that you will not copy or permit the photocopying of any materials, nor disclose or permit the disclosure or sell or hire the same to third parties, nor use the same for running your own courses unless agreed in advance and in writing by IBA-DRF.

3. Qualification

In order to be eligible for membership to the panel a prospective member must provide evidence of partaking in an internationally recognized mediation training course of at least 40 hours from an institute recognized by IBA and provide evidence of quality of their training. Members must also demonstrate a commitment to continued professional growth in the underlying principles and competence in mediation skills by undertaking at least one Continued Professional Development Course every year with IBA. Until such Continued Professional Development Course is undertaken, a mediator cannot practice mediation.

4. Professional conduct

That you represent that no proceedings for professional misconduct or any criminal proceedings were ever instituted or pending against you in or outside of Pakistan.

5. Indemnity

All information provided by IBA-DRF is given in good faith and IBA-DRF will not be held responsible for actions taken by a member or a prospective member or any other individual or organization as a result of the information provided by IBA-DRF.

6. Queries
