Designing 7 Learning Corners in Early years classrooms using low cost material

Overview:

Research in early childhood development has shown that young children learn best in an active hands-on environment. Availability of these learning corners have a positive influence on the development of children's language, their personal, emotional and social skills who participate in the activities designed in the environments Children are given choices which helps them become better decision-makers

The materials in the learning corners are organized to help children engage in meaningful learning. Examples are listening corner, block corner, writing corner, and puppet areas, dramatic play, small motor play (puzzles, Legos, small manipulative), cooking, water/sand play, art, music, science, library corners, storytelling activities etc. In this 24 hours course, you will learn to make different teaching materials using low cost materials and realia which promote fun and pleasure in learning both in the classrooms and also at home.
