An analytical mindset is not problem-focused, it's solution-focused and action-oriented. It involves both analysis and imagination.

Analytical thinking helps you compare sets of data from different sources; identify possible cause and effect patterns, logical thinking and draw appropriate conclusions from the data-sets in order to arrive at appropriate solutions. Focused on listening, user empathy, whole-brain thinking, collaboration, and experimentation, analytical thinking can be applied in any field—from architecture and design to healthcare and product development to urban planning and beyond.
